- explore an 1883 Victorian one room school and its extensive museum
- tour a pioneer house and historic bank
- check out the Odebolt Historical Museum
- learn about the two largest row crop farms in Iowa – the Adams and Cook Ranches
- see or visit an 1904 Carnegie Library
- discover Odebolt's first carriage house built in 1883
- admire the details of large wood carvings
- locate the Cracker Jack seed drying building and cribs
- stroll fragrant gardens at the Prairie Pedlar
- marvel at the pre-fab construction of a Sears barn and a 1900's style one room school on its original Cook Ranch site
